Clini-link is a web app built to connect clinicians who have project ideas with qualified and capable design engineers. The app allows for freelance design engineers to collaborate with clinicians who need items built for their particular clinics. Currently there is no dedicated platform for this but there are some that are similar which we took inspiration from to mould our web app.

The user enters the website and chooses to sign up as either a clinician or a design engineer. If they sign up as a design engineer they're required to enter their Engineers Ireland number, this is checked against the database to ensure they're a certified engineer. Once the engineer logs in they're met by their profile which they can personalise for themselves. They can also add in any particular skills that they have including any experience or qualifications that they have. This allows the engineers to set themselves apart from the rest of the engineers and in turn will lead to them being more likely to be picked by the clinicians to work for them.

When the clinician signs up and logs in they're also able to customize their profile. They can then add a project they would like built, they can also go in and see all the projects that they have submitted to be built with all the information for them. Once their project is complete they can just delete it. The clinician can also view previous engineers who they have worked with on previous projects. The clinician has the ability to find different engineers too and view reviews on the particular engineer. The clinician can also see what other projects are currently out there and have been submitted by other clinicians including their own previous submissions.
